Labrador Judge – Mrs K Bambrook (Ravoakar)

Thank you to the committee for your kind invitation to judge at your open show and for all the exhibitors for your entries. I was pleased with my main winners especially BOB getting Group 3 but most dogs in the classes could have changed places on a different day.

Puppy (5.0)

1 Thorpe's Suttonpark Penny Wise for Taph – An 8.5 month old yellow bitch, a kind expression with correct eye colour and proportioned features. Good fore chest, neck and shoulder placement. Tail set nicely off the back which already is showing it's 'otter tail' features. This bitch is well off for bone without being overdone and has plenty of correct coat. She moved smoothly fore and aft on nice tidy feet. Showed well. BP

2 Woodall's Mattand a Million Dreams for Thirlmere – A 7 month old yellow bitch in smaller proportion to winner but still balanced. A feminine head with correct eye colour and pigmentation. A good shoulder placement, level topline and good tail set. In good coat, and moved well once settled.

3 Allen's Warringah's Wirrabara at Timouren

Junior (3,0)

1 Hutchinson's Glosmere the Grenadier – A 14.5 month yellow dog with a masculine head without being over done. Good eye colour and pigmentation. Good neck, ~~although~~ a little heavy at the moment but could feel a good lay of shoulder, a level topline and a splendid otter tail. He has good bone and moves well once settled. RBOB.

2 Mutter's Incantator Brizo – A 17 month old black bitch with a feminine head, good eye colour and well set ears. A level topline and well set tail almost wagging constantly. She has enough bone and tidy feet and moved well for her handler.

3 Smith's Flyenpyg Where Ya Bin

Post Graduate (2,0)

1 Hutchinson's Glosmere the Grenadier (as Junior)

2 O'dell & Bills Vetybonbetty Chocolate Box – A 2 year chocolate dog with a masculine head and nice eye colour. Good fore chest and lay of shoulder, level top line and well set tail. Not in best coat today but moved well.

Limit (3,0)

1 Allen's Timouron Legacy – A 3 year yellow dog with a masculine head without being over done. Nice eye colour and proportioned features. He has a good lay of shoulder, level topline and well set on tail using it to advantage on the move. He has plenty of correct coat and is well off for bone. Standing on nice tidy feet, this dog has to be the most balanced exhibit under me today. He moved well once settled, pleased to give him BOB and see him get Grp 3.

2 Smith's Flyenpyg Snout Like It – A 5 year yellow bitch, good eye colour with feminine features. Good angulation, enough bone and coat, moved well.
